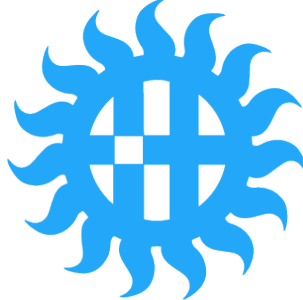

BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

On October 20, 2020, the City adopted a citywide Climate Action Plan (Res. 21-060) that set targets for greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reductions, strategies, and requirements to incorporate up-to-date climate science and projections into relevant City planning and policy decisions. The baseline GHG emissions inventory covered municipal and communitywide emissions during 2018. A second GHG inventory, covering similar GHG emissions in 2023, provides a 5-year review of the City's progress toward the Climate Action Plan goals.

The master plan will address key areas such as emergency response, community risk reduction, resource allocation, and the future growth of the department. Additionally, the session will focus on aligning the master plan with broader citywide strategic goals.
