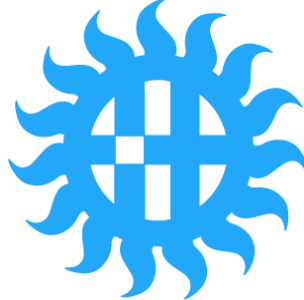

BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

The Connect Las Cruces initiative was developed as part of a citywide approach to extending the use of the GIS enterprise. The playbook goals included modernizing GIS technology, expanding the use of location intelligence, and encouraging self-service to achieve departmental goals and objectives.

GIS technology is a spatial system that creates, manages, analyzes, and maps all types of data. It connects data to a visual representation, like a map, and integrates where things are with what things are like. Our GIS program provides data and analytical support to users across the organization.

GIS staff will be sharing examples of how this technology is used with enterprise data in the process, supports programs of the City organization, and benefits the residents and businesses of Las Cruces.
