BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

The ASCMV (Animal Services Center of the Mesilla Valley) is a joint powers entity between the City of Las Cruces and Dona Ana County since 2008. ASCMV is housed within a City-owned building and a General Obligation (GO) Bond financed expanded/second building on the same property planned to be open in calendar year 2021.

Previously, consideration has been given by the City Manager's Office to rescind the Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) for the ASCMV and bring it into the City organization as a department, merged with the City's Animal Control Officers, which are currently housed within the Police Department. An overview will be provided of such proposed action, other ancillary steps associated with such a move, the budget implications, and other items necessary to undertake should no action occur (i.e. update to the JPA, funding formula, and lease of the buildings).
