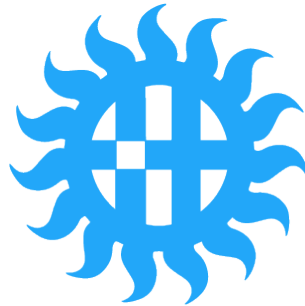

**BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:**

This presentation will include an overview of Neighborwoods was presented to CLC Council in 2023 by Shannon Horst of Tree New Mexico. Dona Ana SWCD applied for the Forestry Grant (partnering with Tree NM) and CLC gave a letter of support with the sustainability officer offering \$10,000. The CLC heat index survey was part of the science behind the need for more trees in Las Cruces. DASWCD was awarded a five year, \$1,000,000 grant in 2024. There have been two tree plantings since the grant award - being mentored by Tree NM with four tree plantings coming up in Oct-Nov. During the duration of the grant, 2,100 (15 gallon) trees will be planted in Las Cruces and Dona Ana County and with a give away of 2,100 (5 gallon) trees. The City of Las Cruces Parks Department has donated the trees they received from the Apache Tree grant to DASWCD Neighborwoods, which will be part of the giveaway trees at events and tree planting in Oct-Nov.
